# **Ad-Funded Disinformation on the Ukraine Conflict**



### GDI has observed a number of ad tech companies monetising anti-Ukrainian and anti-Democratic disinformation.

This deck includes examples of ad-funded content promoting a range of harmful adversarial narratives:


- De-nazification: Ukrainians are "Nazis" and "Banderites" who attack civilians. Russia is carefully, methodically and surgically eliminating these Nazis.
- Biological threat: The U.S. government has set up bioweapons labs in Ukraine that are developing "ethnic weapons" to attack Russians.
- Zelenskyy is a terrorist: Ukraine, not Russia, is killing Ukrainian civilians.

These disinformation narratives have been identified across multiple websites in multiple languages.

#### **How GDI defines disinformation**

- Disinformation is more than **overly simple, false dichotomies** such as true vs. false or left vs. right.
- GDI views disinformation through the lens of <u>adversarial</u> <u>narrative</u> conflict. Adversarial narratives:
  - Can be implicit or explicit;
  - Are intentionally misleading;
  - Are adversarial against:
    - at-risk individuals or groups
    - current scientific consensus
    - democracy and key institutions
  - Most importantly, these adversarial narratives create a risk of harm.
- This definition transcends false binaries and identifies disinformation explicitly by adversarial narrative topic, such as anti-immigrant, misogyny, anti-vax etc.

#### Ad tech publisher policies must be updated and enforced

Most of these publishers' policies do not adequately address the breadth of disinformation narratives associated with the Ukraine conflict.

	Specific publisher policy?	Most relevant policy wording
Google	✓	"Due to the war in Ukraine, we will pause monetization of content that exploits, dismisses, or condones the war."
CRITEO	×	Restricted content: "Is hateful or discriminatory to any groups or individuals based upon their race, sex, nationality, religious affiliation, age or sexual orientation"; or, "Promotes, glorifies or condones violence against others."
	×	No publicly available policy.
revcontent.	×	"does not allow any non-satirical political news which is demonstrably false or which is meant to intentionally deceive a consumer."
Yandex	X	Restricted content: "Promoting discrimination based on gender, race, nationality, religious beliefs, social status or income."

#### Immediate policy interventions include:

- **Accountability:** Ensure greater accountability for arbitrary actions and inactions by platforms particularly in relation to international human rights law and other legal obligations.
- Transparency & Data access: Ensure civil society and vetted third parties can access Platform data for scrutiny.
- Crisis management mechanism: Develop a crisis management mechanism to oblige Platforms to take targeted impact assessments and mitigation actions
- European Commission, Council and Parliament trialogue discussion on DSA at a critical stage:
  - Article 17 Strengthening the internal complaint handling mechanism for users.
  - Article 26 Risk assessment, mitigation of risks and algorithms accountability.
- Human Rights: UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights advises companies to carry out
  human rights due diligence that involves identifying and mitigating and adverse impacts on human rights. It is
  vital to ensure the DSA takes a similar inclusive approach.
